## Boarding and alighting at multi-bus zones

At bus zones designed to accommodate two or more buses, uncontrolled boarding and alighting may lead to accidents. Coast Mountain Bus Company operators therefore follow set procedures so that passengers will know what to expect and what to do.

- The first two buses in the zone allow passengers to board or alight.
- Any following buses allow passengers to alight if the operators decide that their vehicles are in a safe position, but passengers may not board.

Passengers waiting to board are asked to wait until their bus reaches one of the first two positions in the zone.
