Doug MacDonald says it involves 16 of the diesel articulated buses.

"It's a safety issue involving the parking brake valve operation.

Apparently in some low air conditions, the brake valve can be in the release position and the alarm ---the maxi-brake alarm system doesn't function."

MacDonald says the problem was picked up during a routine inspection.

No word when the buses will be back on the streets.
