I do not have conclusive proof of the Victoria number but an
unpublished roster which I have shows the SSL units 586,588,589,591

unpublished roster which I have shows the SSL units 586,588,589,591 and 593, with respective serials 2057,2059,2060,2062 and 2064, as having Victoria numbers 904,906,907,909 and 911. From this it is reasonable to assume that S/N 2063 was SSL 592 and Victoria 910. BTW the aforementioned 5 units came to the Lower Mainland as 9691,9692,(2) 5601,9693 and 9694 respectively.
